Dear Applicant,

We are pleased to be able to offer academic scholarships for the upcoming school terms of the year applied. Scholarship awards are available for \$2,000 per academic year to students enrolled in a college, university, community/junior college or technical school.

To be eligible for scholarship consideration, applicant must be a graduating high school senior whose parent or legal guardian is a current or honorably retired peace officer, reserve peace officer, probation officer, correctional officer, emergency medical technician/paramedic, firefighter, or 9-1-1 dispatcher serving with a governmental or volunteer emergency response agency within Fort Bend County, Texas. Past scholarship recipients and current college students are also eligible to reapply/apply for the scholarship for up to four (4) years (eight (8) semesters) while meeting all other eligibility criteria, using the college application.

Scholarships are available to students enrolled in any college, university or technical school that is accredited by an institutional accrediting agency recognized by the U.S Department of Education (US Dept of Education maintains a searchable database: <http://ope.ed.gov/accreditation/Search.aspx>)

Applicants must be enrolled in at least twelve (12) college credit hours or equivalent "full-time" status to receive a scholarship disbursement. Applicant must maintain at least a 2.5/4.0 unweighted grade point average or equivalent "passing" grade to be eligible to reapply for a scholarship. An incomplete or failing grade in any class may cause a suspension of funding for the next term. A sealed official high school transcript is required with this application.

Completed applications **must be emailed and transcripts must be post marked by March 31**. Applications delivered in person will not be accepted. Incomplete applications will not be considered for scholarship. A résumé will not be accepted in lieu of an application. Additional pages may be attached to the application, if needed, to comprehensively answer any questions on the application. An essay is a requirement and must be attached to the application. The essay must be typed, **double-spaced** using **12-point font** and have a **word count at the end** of the essay.

Scholarship finalists will be notified by email to appear for a personal interview. Please see details below for submitting the application via email.

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Eligibility: Any graduating high school senior whose parent or legal guardian is a current or honorably retired peace officer, reserve peace officer, probation officers, correctional officer, emergency medical technician/paramedic, firefighter, or 9-1-1 dispatcher serving with a governmental or volunteer emergency response agency within Fort Bend County.
