## Dear Applicant,

We are pleased to be able to offer academic scholarships for the upcoming school terms of the year applied. Scholarship awards are available for \$2,000 per academic year to students enrolled in a college, university, community/junior college or technical school.

To be eligible for scholarship consideration, applicant must be a graduating high school senior whose is a dependent of a current or honorably retired peace officer, reserve peace officer, probation officer, correctional officer, emergency medical technician/paramedic, firefighter, or 9-1-1 dispatcher serving with a governmental or volunteer emergency response agency within Fort Bend County, Texas.

Scholarships are available to students who will be enrolled in at least twelve (12) college credit hours or equivalent "full-time" status. They can attend any college, university or technical school that is accredited by an institutional accrediting agency recognized by the U.S Department of Education (US Dept of Education maintains a searchable database: http://ope.ed.gov/accreditation/Search.aspx) to receive a scholarship disbursement.

Applicants must be a graduating high school senior and must have at least a 2.5/4.0 unweighted grade point average or equivalent "passing" grade to be eligible to apply for a scholarship. An incomplete or failing grade in any class may cause a suspension of funding for the next term. An official high school transcript is required with this application.

Completed applications **must be emailed by 5:00 P.M. March 1**. Applications delivered in person will not be accepted. A résumé will not be accepted in lieu of an application. Additional pages may be attached to the application, if needed, to comprehensively answer any questions on the application. An official high school transcript is required with this application as well as two current letters of recommendation, a headshot and responses to short answer questions are required and must be attached to the application. Incomplete applications will not be considered for a scholarship.

Scholarship finalists will be notified by email to sign up for interviews that will be held in April. Be prepared to discuss Behind the Badge Charities during the interview. Any deviation from scheduled times or designated procedures will be subject to review by the Scholarship Committee on an individual basis.
